As well as business, Bronwyn also has a background in tertiary education, and part-time University lecturer for 12 years.

Now, she has the opportunity to combine her two lifelong interests – Small Business and Education – and has turned her own personal business successes into an international speaking and mentorship program.

Today, Bronwyn is a leader in her field, sharing the stage with like-minded dynamic leaders, thinkers and entrepreneurs, including Andrew Griffiths, international bestselling author, global speaker and inspirational mentor. Bronwyn regularly appears on radio and television, and is a columnist for some of the largest broadcast communities in Australia.


